Program in a Nutshell

- Ready to take your leadership skills to the next level?
- Are you called to lead but worry you don't have the necessary skills to inspire a team?
- Do you have ambitions to take on a leadership role in your practice, in organized medicine or in your community?
- Do you simply need to finesse your leadership style?

Program Goals

- Develop leaders in emergency medicine.
- Provide advocacy training to promote emergency medicine.
- Prepare program graduates for leadership positions.
- Encourage relationship-building, networking, and mentorship.

Who Should Apply?

- Nominee/Applicant must be a current member in good standing with Ohio ACEP and be **board-certified or board-eligible** in EM, ideally in the first eight years of practice.
- Nominee/Applicant must have a minimum of two years membership in ACEP or EMRA
- Nominee/Applicant **must agree** to attend all scheduled sessions.



What is Needed to Apply?

- A complete application which includes background and contact information, leadership experience in organized medicine or the community, and a statement of interest.
- One letter of reference that speaks to the applicant's leadership performance or potential, and commitment to continued development.
- A current CV.

Fees and Expenses

- Cost for participation will be shared by Ohio ACEP and the physician participant.
- Program costs and applicable registration fees will be covered by Ohio ACEP such as conference registration fees, speakers and program materials, leadership development tools and networking events.
- Travel and hotel accommodations are the responsibility of the physician participants such as lodging, meals, and travel to/from all sessions listed in the program, including the ACEP Leadership & Advocacy Conference in Washington, DC, ACEP Council in Denver, Colorado and events in Columbus, Ohio.

Participant Selection/Applications Due May 28, 2019

- The Leadership Development Committee will review and select participants based on completed nomination forms postmarked by May 28, 2019.
- Selected participants will be notified immediately following the decision.
- Nominees who are not selected for the 2019-2020 class may be re-nominated the following cycle.
