## Program Overview

## Program Goals

- Develop leaders in emergency medicine

## Who Should Apply?

- Applicant must be a current member in good standing with Ohio ACEP and be **board-certified or board-eligible** in EM, ideally in the first eight years of practice.
- Applicant must have a minimum of two years membership in ACEP or EMRA.
- Applicant must agree to attend all scheduled sessions.

## What is Needed to Apply?

- A complete application which includes background and contact information, leadership experience in organized medicine or the community and a statement of interest.
- One letter of reference that speaks to the applicant's leadership performance or potential and commitment to continued development.
- A current CV

## Fees and Expenses

- Cost of participation will be shared by the participant and Ohio ACEP.
- Ohio ACEP will cover program costs, applicable registration fees, program materials and networking events.
- Physician participants will be responsible for hotel accommodations, meals, and travel to/from sessions including ACEP Leadership & Development (Washington DC), ACEP Council (San Francisco, CA) and program and Chapter events (Columbus, Ohio).

## Participant Selection/Applications Due: April 22

- The Leadership Development Committee will select (4) four participants based on completed nomination forms submitted by March 30, 2022.
- Selected participants will be notified in April.
- Nominees who are not selected for the 2022-2023 class may be re-nominated the following cycle.
